

Ozge Serçeler was born in 1989 in Kayseri, Turkey. She started her music education in Ankara Anatolian Fine Arts High School in 2004. In 2005, she took the audition for Bilkent University Faculty of Music and Performing Arts Music High School. Thanks to her outstanding success in her audition, she continued her studies with Gara Aliyev with the full scholarship both for school and dormitory. During her four years of education there, she gave concerts and recitals in many cities in Turkey. (Bursa, Ankara etc.) In 2008, she was successful in the audition which is held by the Royal College of Music in London. In the same year, she passed the audition held by Anadolu University State Conservatory Music Department for her undergraduate education and started her education there by Prof. Dr. Ozan Evrim Tunca. Özge Serçeler actively participated in various masterclasses in her education life. Şölen Dikener (2011), Benyamin Sönmez (2011), Çağ Erçağ (2011-12), Efe Baltacıgil (2012), Dennis Parker (2013), Borislav Strulev (2014), Evgeni Rachyev(2020). Özge Serçeler, who has given various recitals and concerts since 2005, passed the concerto competition held by Anadolu University in 2011 and played the E. Lalo cello Concerto with the Anatolian Youth Symphony Orchestra under the conductorship of Burak TÜZÜN in June. In addition to solo concerts and recitals, she also took part in various orchestras. In 2011-12, she took part as co-principal in the Turkish Youth Symphony Orchestra under the conductorship of Cem Mansur. In 2013, she took part in the Bilkent Symphony Orchestra for the Mahler 8th Symphony prepared for the Ankara Music Festival. In the same year, she also took part in the Antalya State Symphony Orchestra, where events such as the Aspendos festival are held from time to time. In 2014, she continued playing for the Bilkent Symphony Orchestra. In September 2014, she played Beethoven 9th Symphony with the Bilkent Youth Symphony Orchestra within the scope of Beethovenfest and participated in a tour to Berlin. The artist, who won the Mersin State Opera and Ballet audition in 2015, regularly took part in performances. In the same year, she also took part in Bursa Regional State Symphony Orchestra, Antalya State Symphony Orchestra, Çukurova State Symphony Orchestra. The artist, who started to work with the Antalya State Symphony Orchestra in the 2015-2017 season, had the opportunity to work with famous conductors such as Gürer Aykal, Alexander Rahbari, Marek Pijarowsky, Emil Tabakov, Matthew Coorey, Adrian Prabava and Antonio Pirolli. Between October 2017-2019, the artist served as the assistant principal in the Çukurova State Symphony Orchestra as a contracted guest artist. The artist, who started her master's education in 2021 by winning the exam opened by Stephen F. Austin University, continues her education with Dr. Evgeni Rachyev. She has assistantships for SFA Orchestra and Music Prep Division. The artist periodically works as a contract artist in the Longview, Texarkana and Shevreport symphony orchestras.
